Sportbike Open

What a finish, what a race! #1 Oliver Svendsen crowns an already successful IDM debut with a spectacular double victory in the new sportbike class of the International German Motorcycle Championship (IDM) in Oschersleben. After a dramatic race on Sunday, the Dane also took victory in the second race — by a razor—thin margin of just 0.03 seconds ahead of Petr Svoboda. #87 Anton Södergren had bad luck in the first race and crashed. In the second race, he was able to improve his pace and finished in tenth position.

In the championship, #1 Oliver Svendsen leads confidently. #87 Anton Södergren is in fourteenth position in the championship. An entry as one would imagine.

The mechanics team around the sportbike project has delivered excellent work and was able to gradually improve performance in coordination with the riders.

Supersport 600 next Generation

A big challenge lies ahead in the Supersport 600 next Generation class. Inigo Iglesias, who competed in the 300 World Championship as part of the World SBK in 2024, has showcased his talent. With positions 11 and 9, he achieved a top ten finish. Although this may not appear very successful at first glance, it is indeed an excellent performance. Due to the limited number of dry test days during preparation, there was much adjustment work for the team and the rider. With very little track time available during a race weekend, there is no time for development. Despite the limited riding time, Inigo was able to improve his lap time by 2 seconds. Even with two points-scoring results, the Supersport department is willing to make some changes to enhance the package.

Before the second race event of the IDM in Schleiz, the team will undertake 4 test days to further develop the vehicles.
























