Third Race Event Schleiz

The Triumph Germany Racing Team had a big task ahead of them after the second race event in Schleiz. The team around Kor Veltmann and Lothar Kraus had their hands full regrouping and setting up the perfect team. The reward for this incredible commitment was a near-perfect race weekend.



The fastest in practice on Friday, the team demonstrated its quality with pole position on Saturday and a win in race one. #1 Oliver Svendsen extended his championship lead. Anton Södergren is currently ranked XXX in the Sportbike Open class championship standings.

Race 1:

In race 1 on Saturday afternoon, the temperatures were very hot, as they had been all weekend. After a good start, both Triumph Germany Racing riders, #1 Oliver Svendsen and #87 Anton Södergren, found themselves in first and second place. Oliver was able to take advantage of his good pace and gradually pull away from his pursuers. #87 Anton Södergren was able to compete well for positions 2-4 in the first half of the race. Unfortunately, he had to park his bike because he had a temperature problem and wanted to conserve the material - very clever. A shame, as he had his sights set on the podium. #1 Oliver Svendsen took a controlled start to finish victory, with a lead of almost 5 seconds over the second placed driver.



Race 2:

A brilliant start leads to numerous overtaking maneuvers. #1 Oliver Svendsen leads the race from the fourth lap and sets the pace. In a thrilling final phase, he takes second place, five thousandths of a second behind, securing a solid championship lead. #87 Anton Södergren also delivers a podium-caliber race, delivering his best result of the season so far. With fourth place, he now ranks twelfth overall and closes in on the top


























