Sasha de Vits for gueststarter

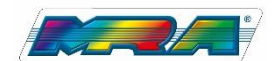

Unfortunately, due to a crash during training and the resulting injury, Oliver was unable to participate in two races. This left Oliver without a chance to fight for those 50 points.

Despite missing 50 points, the Triumph Germany Racing Team with Oliver Svendsen is in second place in the championship, just five points behind first place.

An exciting finale is expected.

Oliver Svendsen: Oliver is still limited by his injuries. Together, we want to use the two remaining races at the finale in Hockenheim to collect the points needed to win the championship. That's our clear goal. We want to proudly display the number 1 on the starting grid again next season.
