For Oliver Svendsen, the race weekend began with a medical check. Due to the injury he sustained during testing, he was declared unfit for the Assen event two weeks ago and was unable to start. The race doctors performed his medical check on Thursday, and he is expected to start.

Despite the significant handicap caused by his injuries, he managed to secure a very strong fourth place in qualifying. He started the race from the second row. He got off to a good start and established himself in the leading group. He secured a second-place finish! An incredible performance under these circumstances!

For race two on Sunday afternoon, the goal was to score as many points as possible and secure at least second place. But then a motorsport thriller unfolded. Oliver crashed during the warm-up lap. His racing bike was transported to the technical inspection station in a van. The team then began repairs outside the pit lane. Oliver was examined for injuries by medical personnel and only then released back into the pit lane. All of this happened within 15 minutes. He started from the pit lane four laps down; to score points, he would have had to complete 75% of the race distance, 10 laps. Unfortunately, he was flagged off after nine laps! His efforts were unfortunately not rewarded in the second race.

Second in the championship, only five points behind the championship leader, everyone is eagerly awaiting the season finale on September 28th in Hockenheim.
